Summary of the regular meeting of the board of directors held on July 28, 2011:

Approved minutes from the June Regular Board Meeting a June Special Board Meeting.

- Approved the resignation of Dick Peterson, with regret.
- Named Hal Dunkelberger, Connie Farabaugh, Marian Harbaugh, Ellie Sheen and Amanda Adair as honorary members for the 2011-2012 Rotary year.
- Named Carolyn Wagaman to the 2011-2012 board, filling the vacancy left by Kevin Mahoney's resignation. Carolyn will Chair the Community Service Lane.

Directed that the Club pay dues and other charges for the treasurer and secretary for 2011-2012 as allowed by Article 7, Section 4 of the bylaws.

The Hauser Winery fundraiser will be held Sunday evening, October 16, 2011, to benefit the Rotary Club of Gettysburg Benevolent Fund.

Referred the idea of awarding scholarships to adults returning to college to the Vocational Service Committee for consideration.

The annual district Foundation Dinner will be November 3, 2011.

Membership Committee meetings are on the third Monday each month. It was noted that growth comes from members inviting prospective members more so than the activities of the committee. The committee will conduct a classification inventory to identify target businesses.

- The potential for fundraising projects that tie in with the 150th Anniversary of the battle was discussed, with the discussion to be continued at the August meeting.
