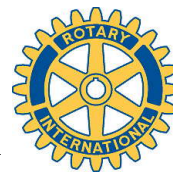

Emily Hillenbrand, a past recipient of the Rotary Ambassadorial Scholarship, spoke about her studies in the Netherlands. Emily studied at the "Institute for Social Studies" in the Hague. Her emphasis was on Women's Studies, for which Emily now has a Master's Degree. Mrs. Hillenbrand emphasized the majority of students at her institution hailed from developing nations, mostly from Asia and Africa. Emily noted that the "Dutch Way" is emphasized by: Pragmatism, Liberalism and Consensus. Politically, nine different parties control the Dutch Parliament. The Netherlands is also known for its lenient drug and prostitution laws, yet despite the many tolerances, the Dutch have marked racial tensions with Turkish and Moroccan Immigrants, who came to work in the '70s and never left. Mrs. Hillenbrand truly cherished her studies in the Netherlands and was grateful for the opportunity afforded her by Rotary.
