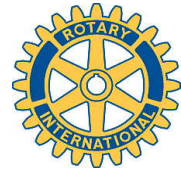

A VERY BUSY DAY AT GETTYSBURG ROTARY CLUB

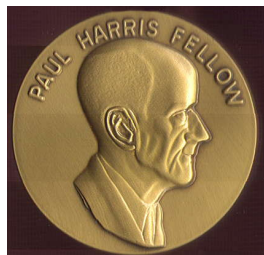
WE AWARDED MONEY TO AREA CHARITIES
