## May 19th Meeting

In a splendid PowerPoint presentation consisting of both slides and video, the latter often accompanied by music, Peter Chen, our Fairfield Exchange Student from Taiwan, offered a clear and interesting presentation of his Chinese homeland. Taiwan (Formerly Formosa) is a small island 245 by 89 miles, with a marine tropical climate and a population of 23 million. It was founded as a state 98 years ago. Ninety-three percent of the population follow Buddhism, Confucianism or Taoism, with Mandarin Chinese being the official language and English the second one. Peter showed examples of both ancient and modern architecture and scenes of great natural beauty, as well as pictures of his hometown and family, not to mention amusing slides of his stay in Adams County and elsewhere in the U.S.

After Peter’s well-received presentation, Carey Moore addressed both the Chair and the Club and expressed the hope that Peter would provide a DVD of his presentation to the Club for its permanent possession, and that the Board consider initiating the practice of *encouraging* ( but not requiring) our Exchange Students to give to the Club a CD or DVD copy of their presentation, thereby providing the Club with a pictorial record of the particular student.
