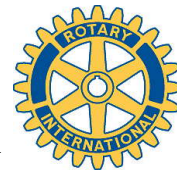

### PROGRAM

The program today was about the Center for Acute Rehabilitative Medicine at the Hanover Hospital. The speaker was Amanda Alvarez, Community Education Coordinator for the Center. The speaker discussed strokes and gave a good description of the Rehab Center. Stroke victims make up much of the case load at the Center and the review of clinical signs, warning signs, and the rehabilitative process was very helpful. She also pointed out that the Hanover Hospital is accepting referrals from the Adams County area and that makes it much more convenient for family and patients who used to travel to Baltimore and other places for help. The Acute Rehab Center treats other conditions such as brain injury, spinal cord injury, trauma injury, hip fracture, severe arthritis, knee and hip replacements, amputations, neurological disorders and other debilitating disorders. Another very informative topic, thanks to Ms Alvarez.
