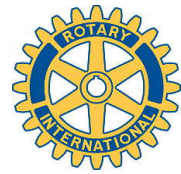

Member Lisa Conklin gave a Power Point presentation on House Bill 2525, to amend the 1982 "Dog Law Act" to further regulate dog breeding businesses in the Commonwealth, to prevent animal abuse and to provide for more humane treatment of these dogs in what are commonly known as "puppy mills".

Bob Kenworthy, gave a moving talk about his experience acquiring polio at age 11 and how he has coped with it as an adult. He recalled his almost year long treatment and rehabilitation separated from his family and how he had to give up all sports but golf, which he played avidly until just two years ago. He applauded the efforts of Rotary International to eradicate polio in the world, and encouraged us to support this effort with our contributions.
